The sculptor Khaled Waleed Al-Aloosi shows in a beamer presentation his works and gives an insight into his working methods.

Khaled Waleed Al-Aloosi, 1977 in Tikrit, Iraq, studied from 1995 to 2000 Sculpture at the Academy of Fine Arts to Baghdad. Since then he worked as a freelancer in Tikrit as a sculptor. He has participated in numerous exhibitions in Iraq and in Dubai. In Iraq, he also organized exhibitions of other artists and gave courses in modeling. An order from the US helped him to greater success. Shortly thereafter, in June 2014 his work was destroyed. For five months Khaled Waleed Al-Aloosi lives as a refugee in Leipzig. He is still active as an artist. Last Wednesday Khaled initiated a workshop in modeling with clay in Pöge-Haus. We are now delighted that there will be an opportunity on Wednesday to see photos of his destroyed works and to start a conversation with the artist.
